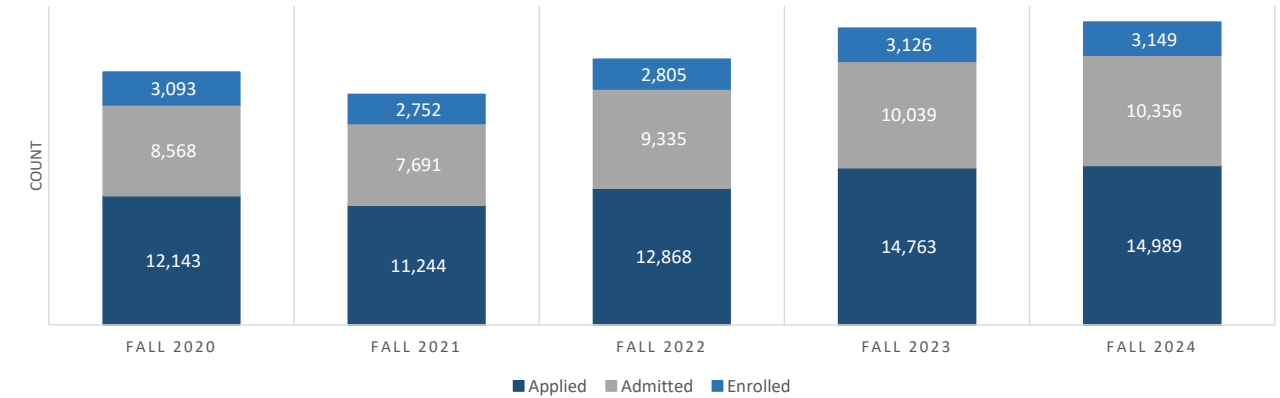

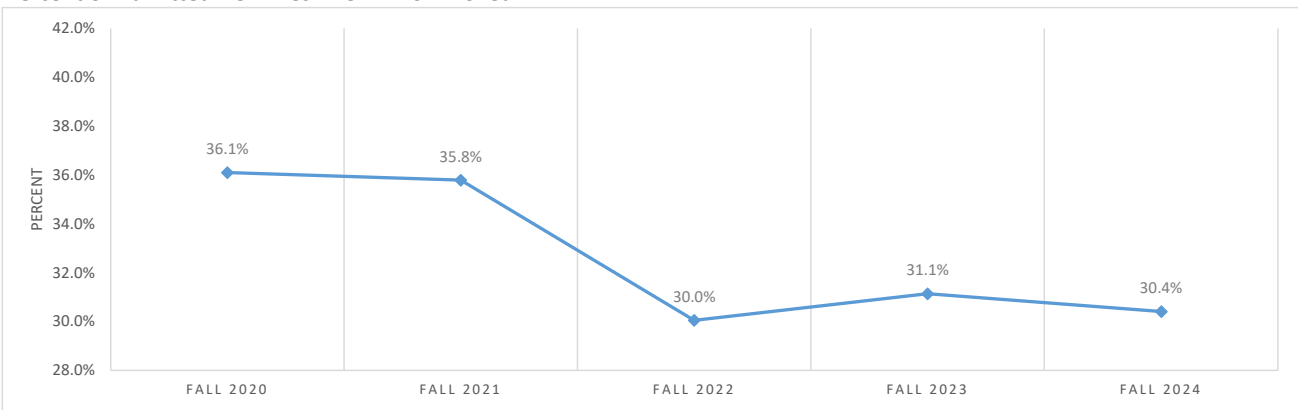

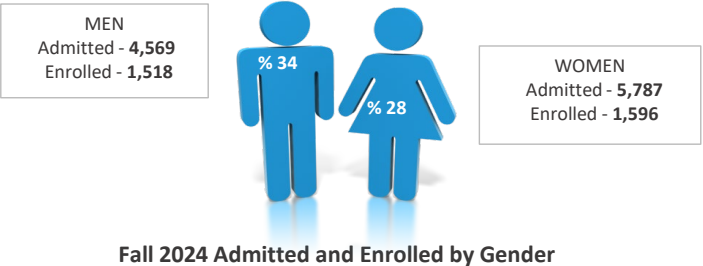
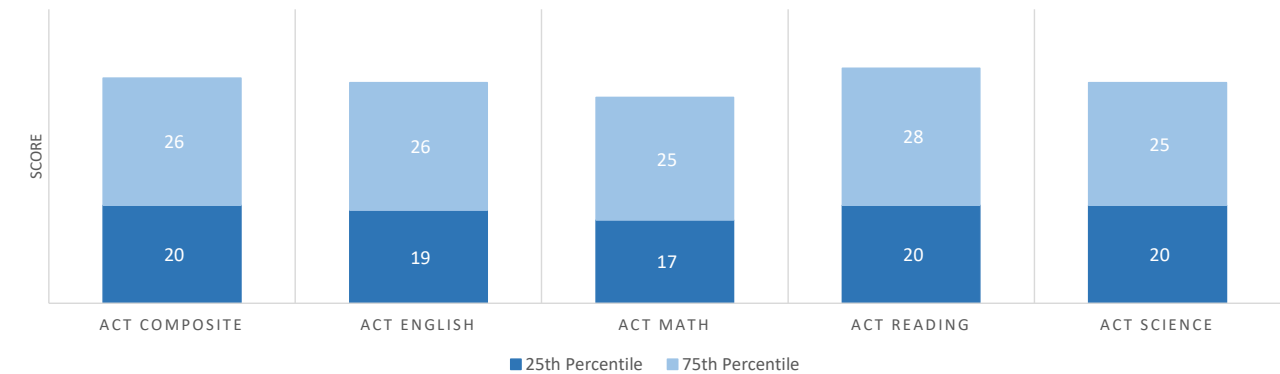
New Freshmen Applied, Admitted and Enrolled

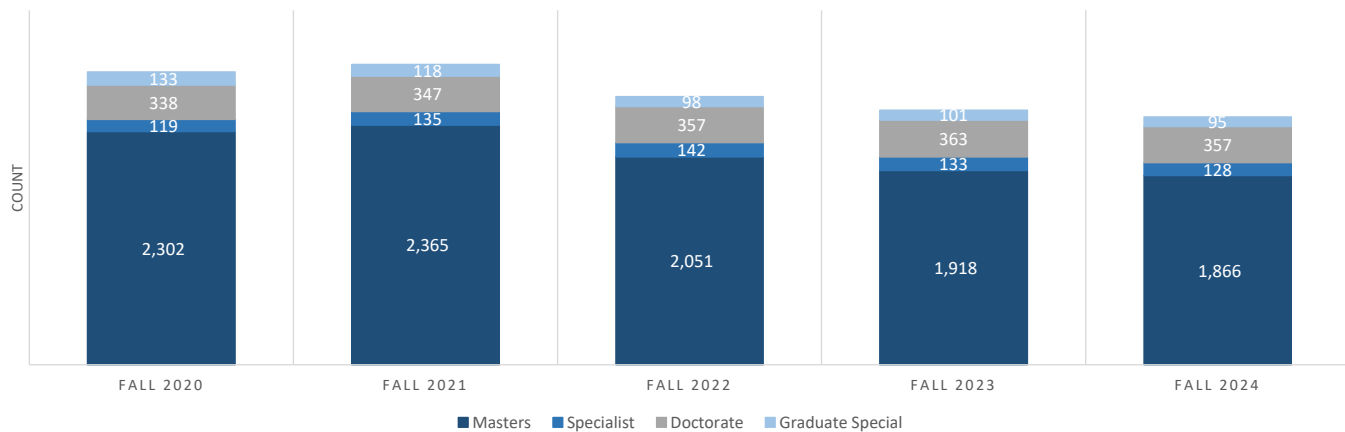

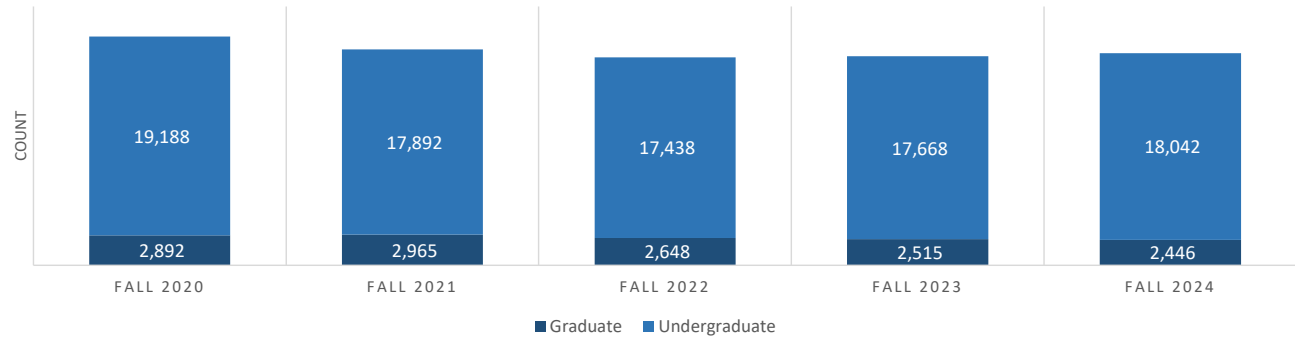

Graduate Headcount by Classification

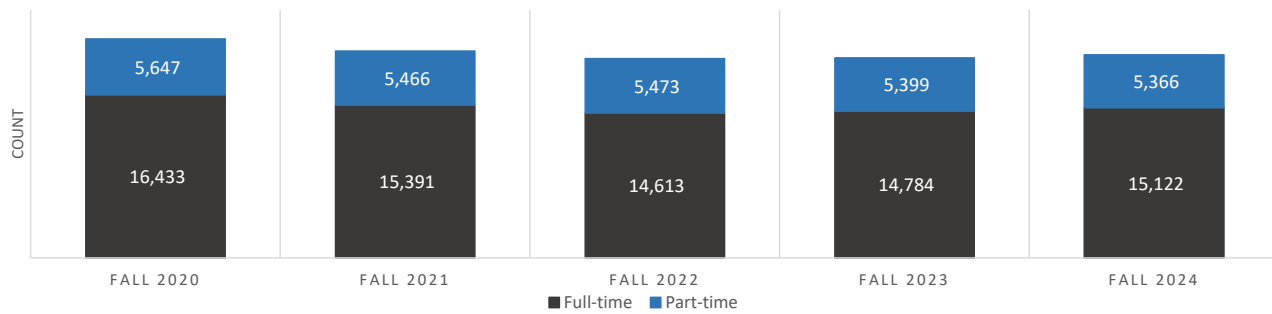

Total Fall Headcount by Enrollment Status



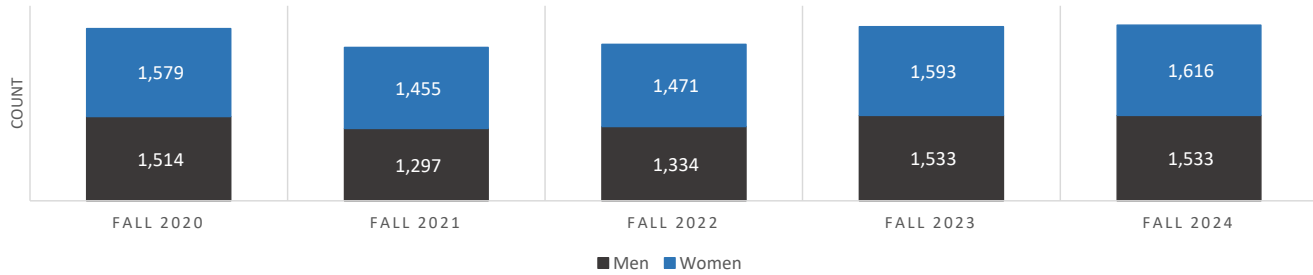

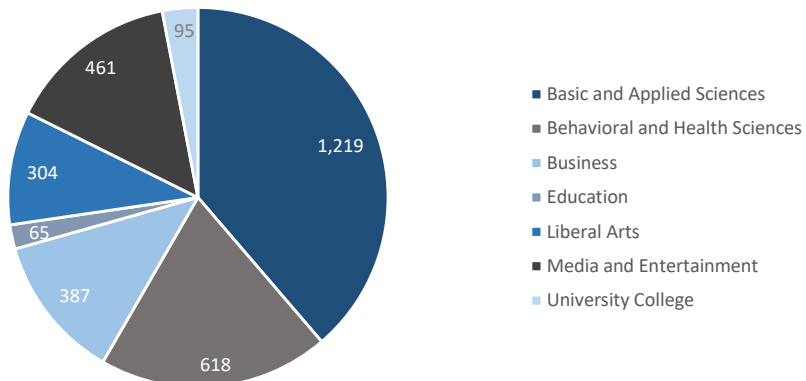

First-time First-Year Students by College



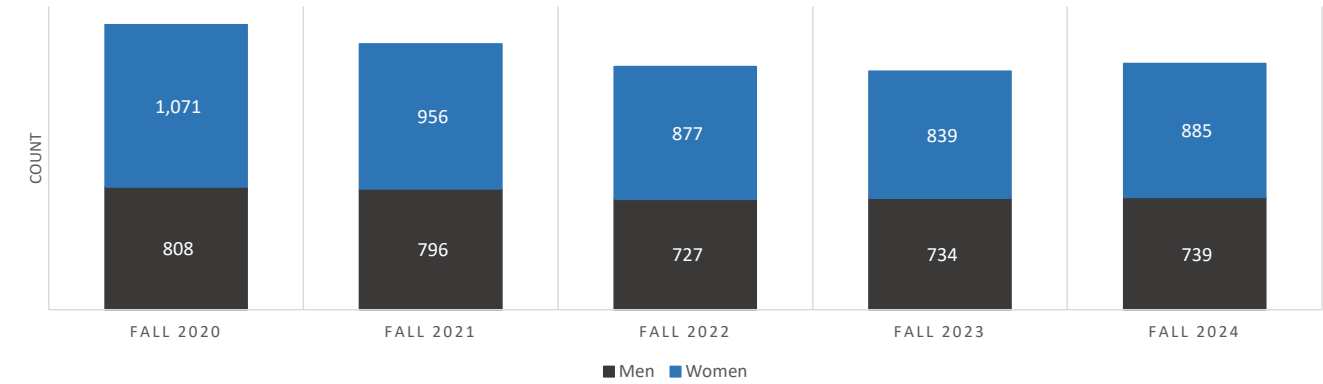

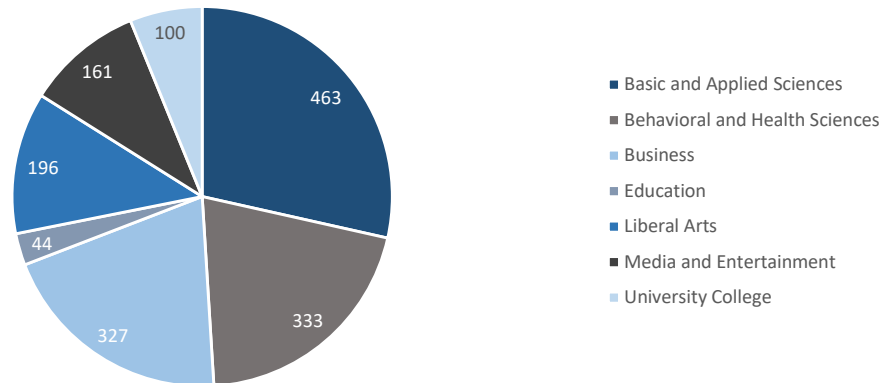

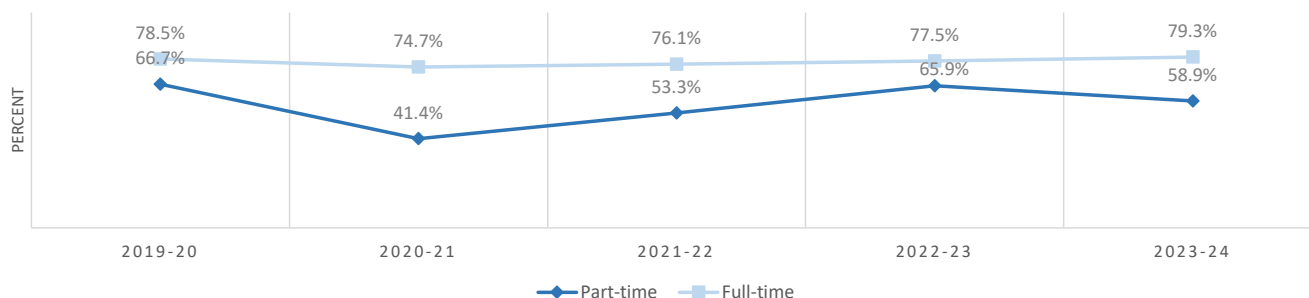

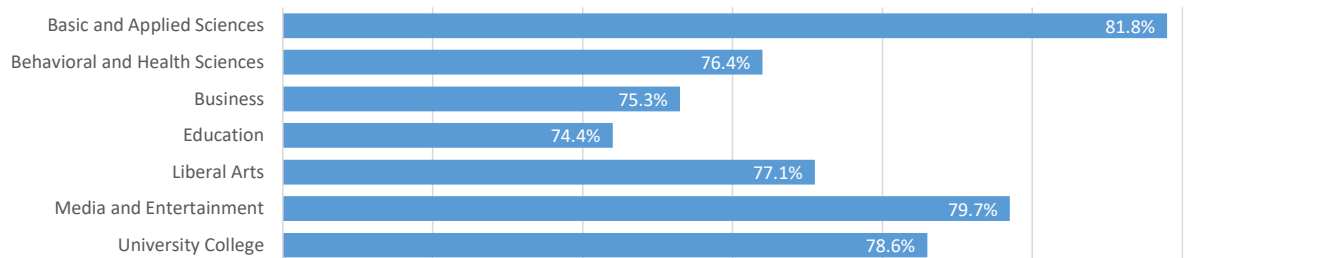

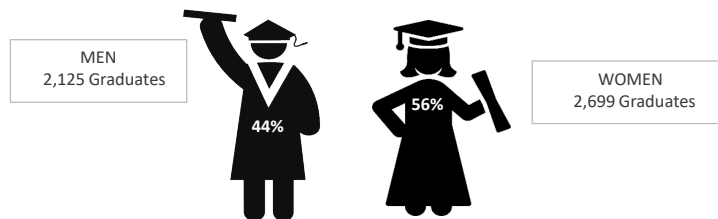

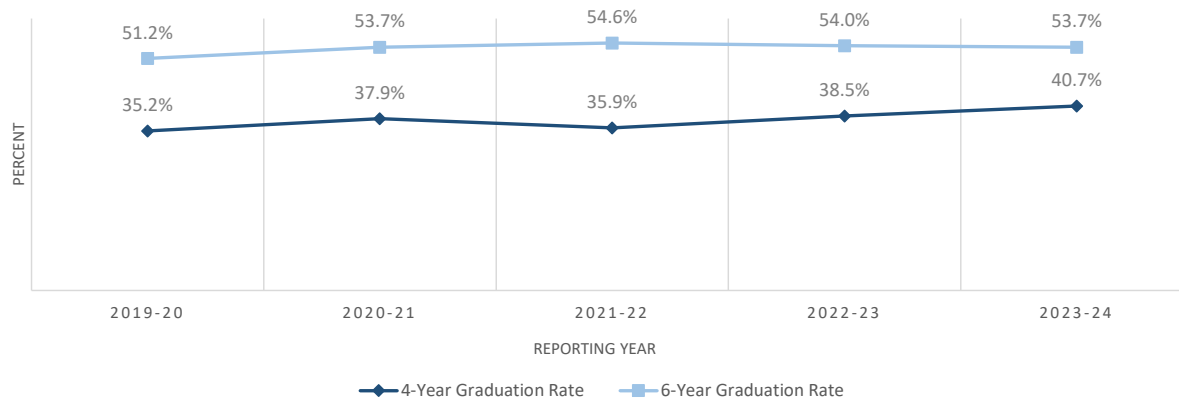

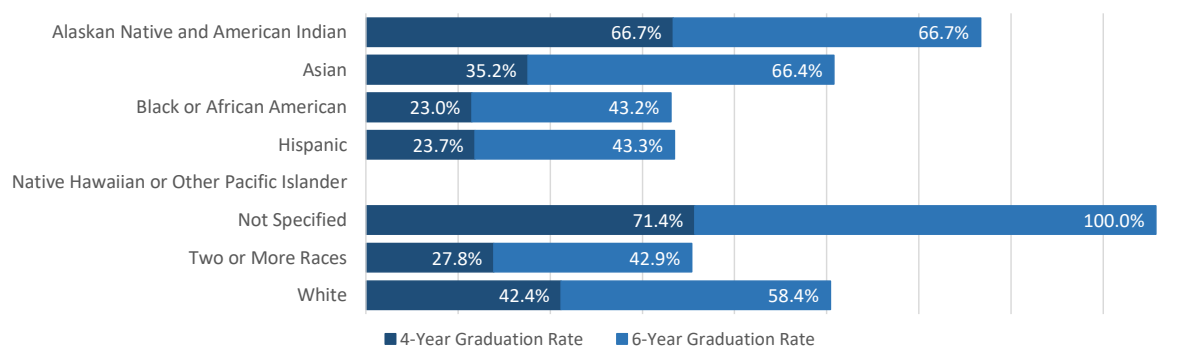

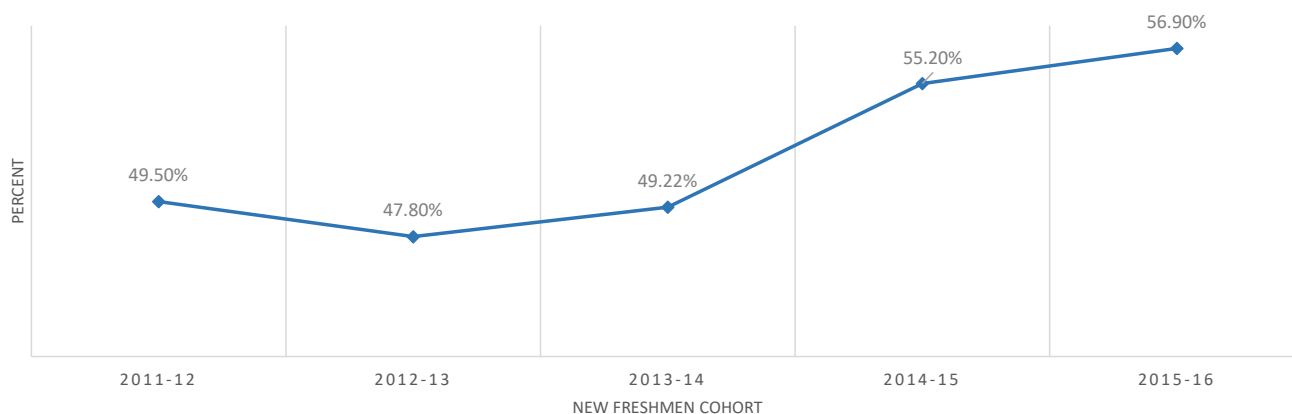
