Effective with the 2018-19 edition of the fact book, all prior summer start freshmen were added to the first-time freshmen cohort.

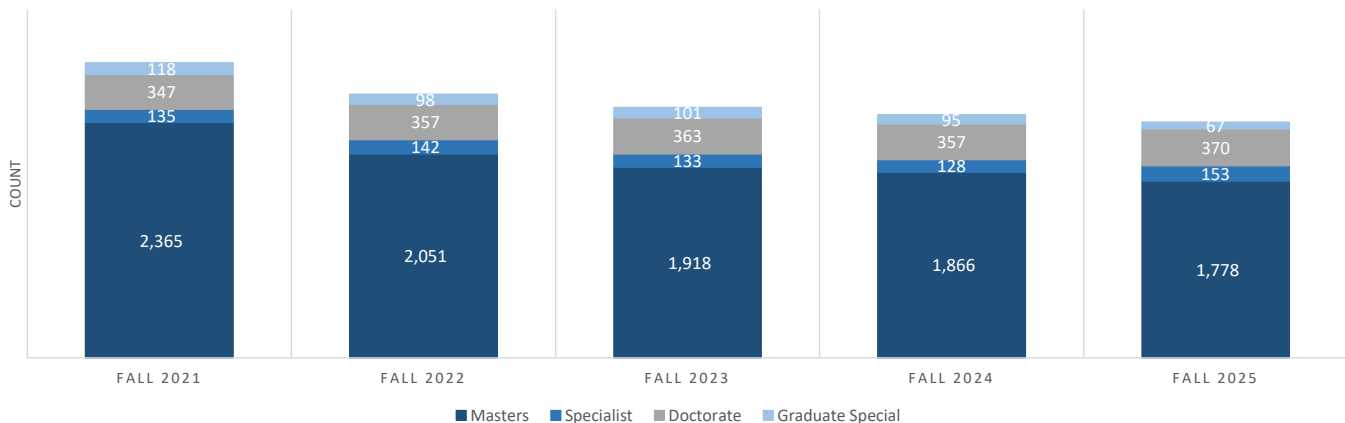

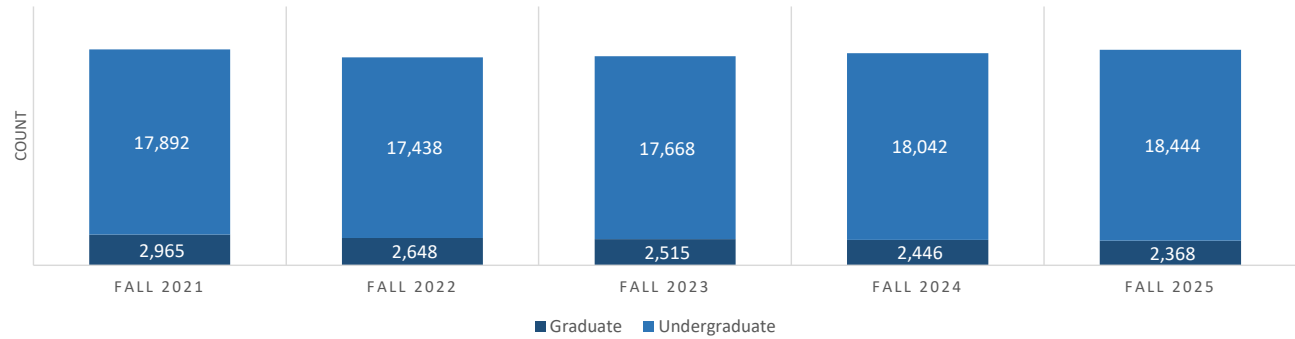

Graduate Headcount by Classification

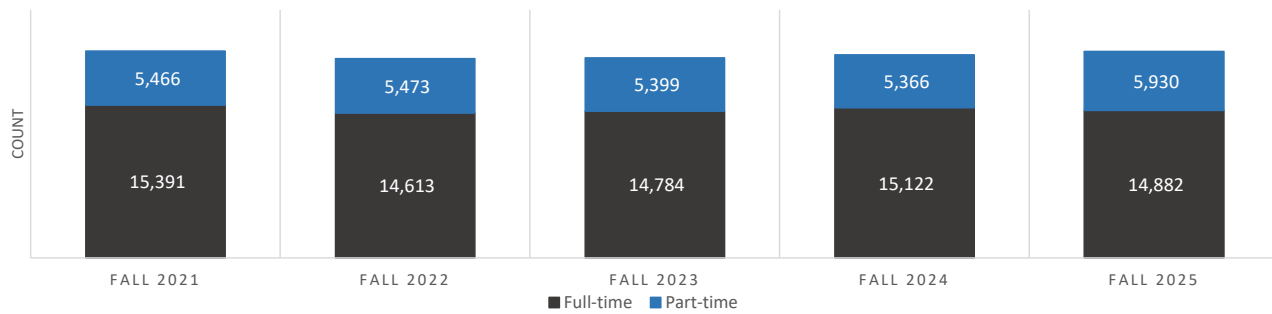

Total Fall Headcount by Full-Time/Part-Time



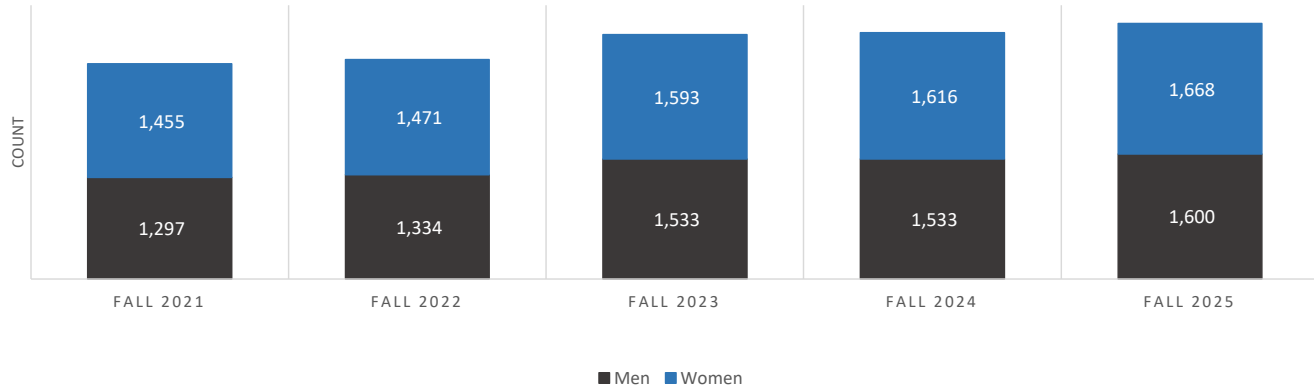

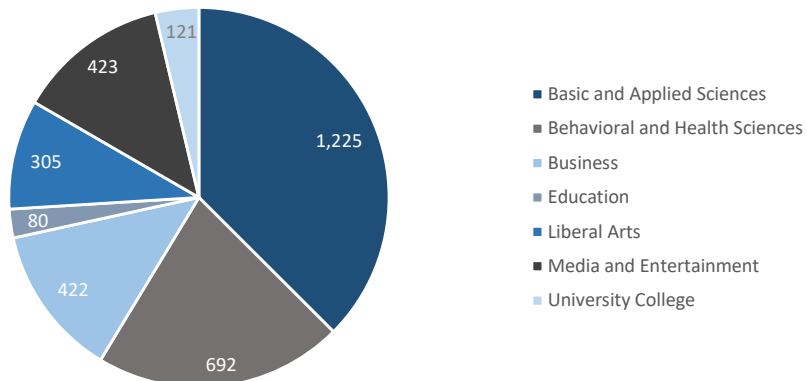

First-time First-Year Students by College



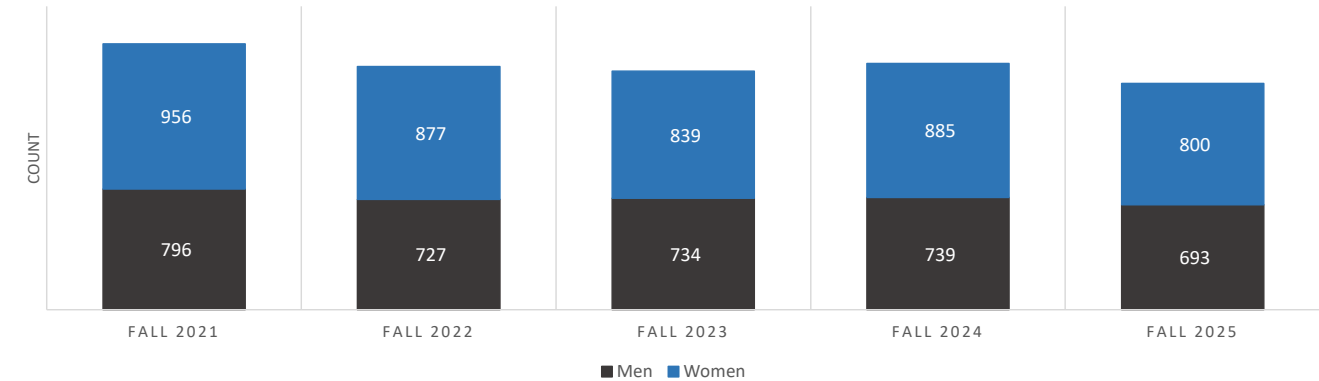

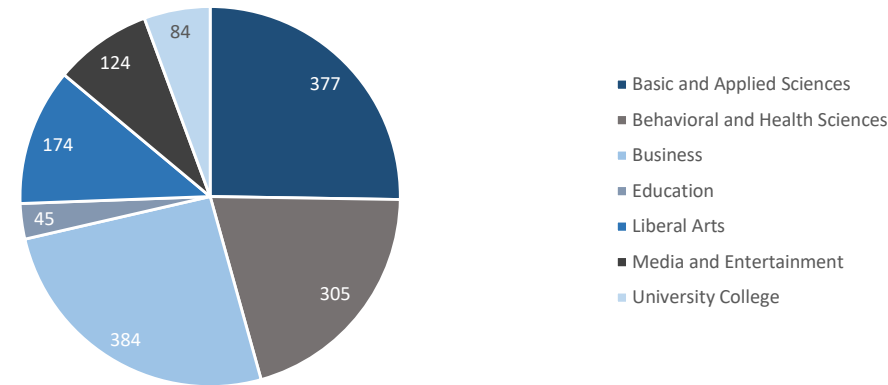

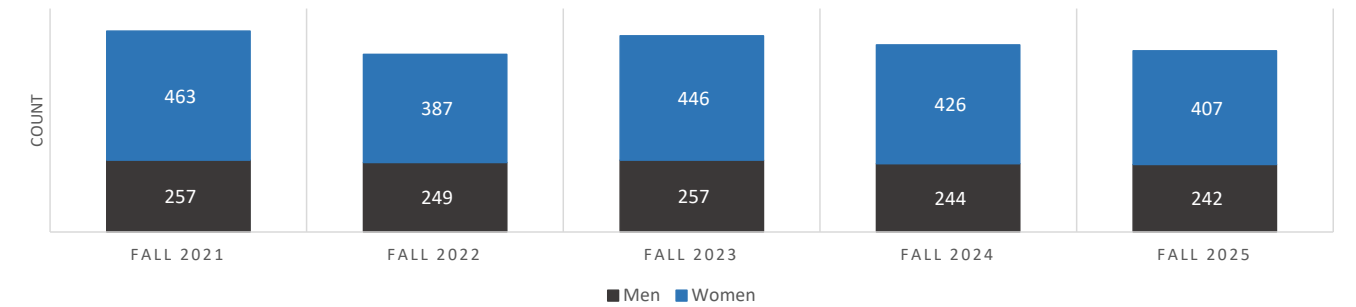

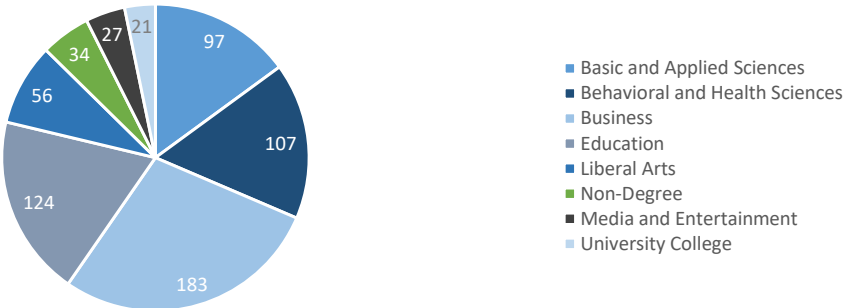

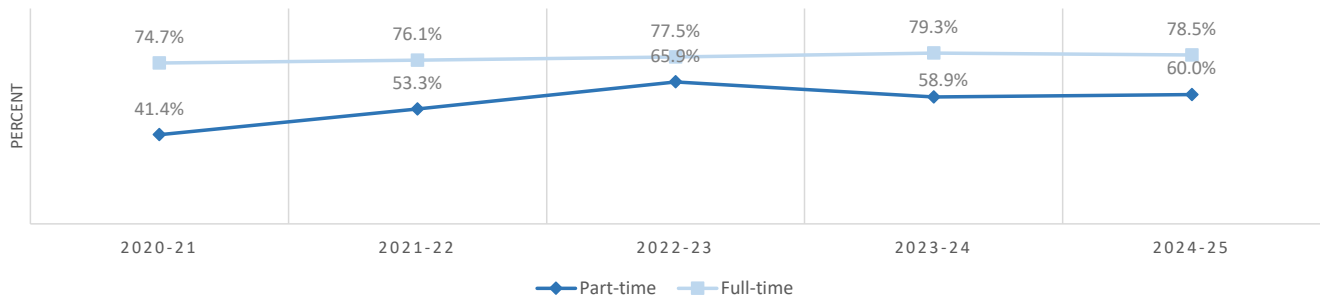

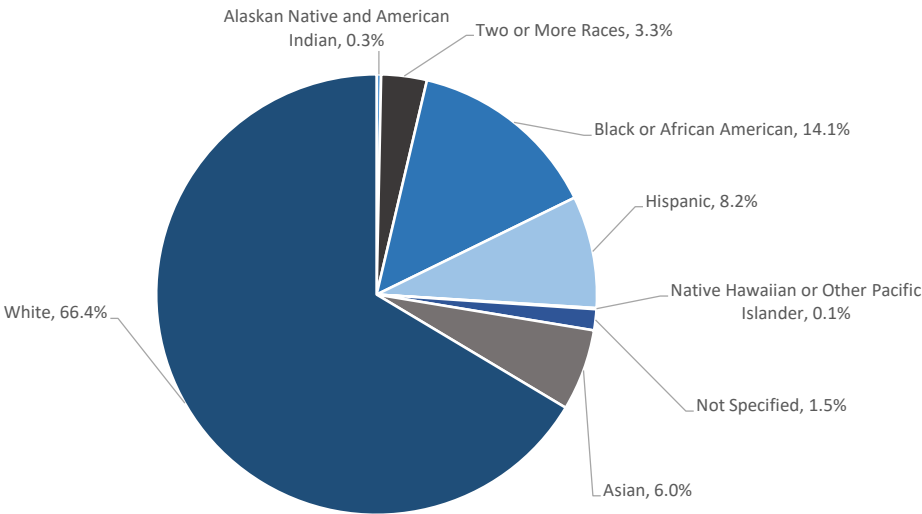

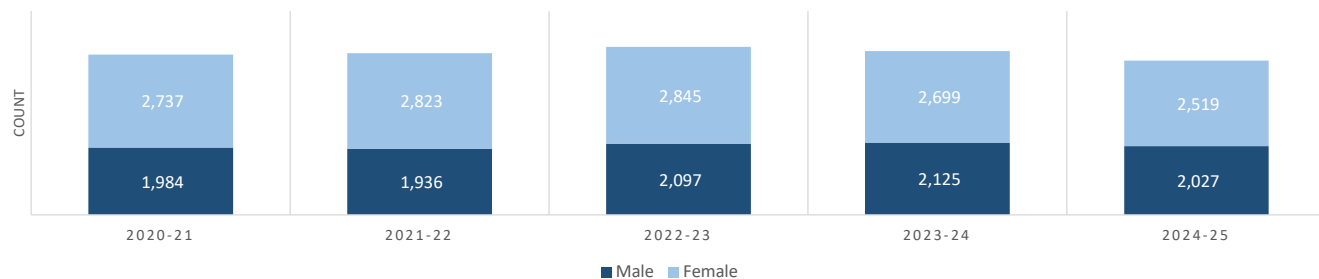

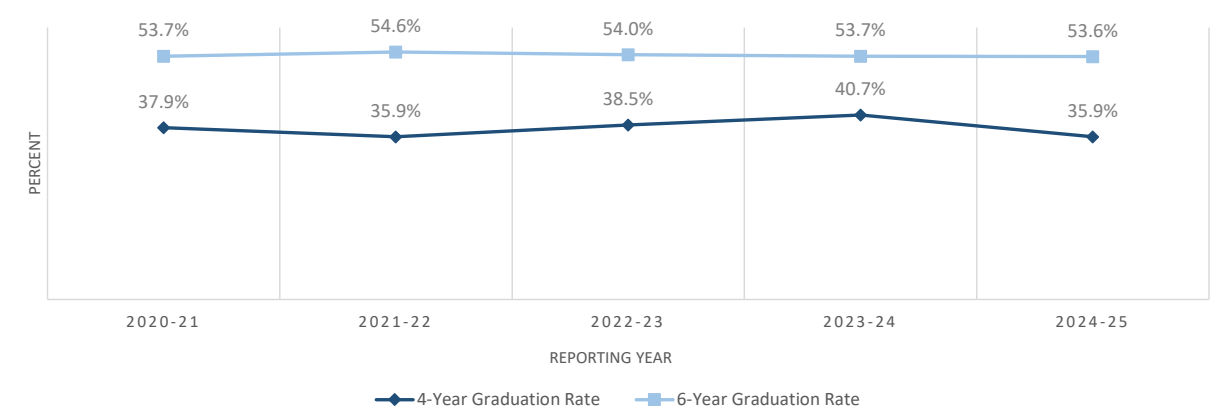

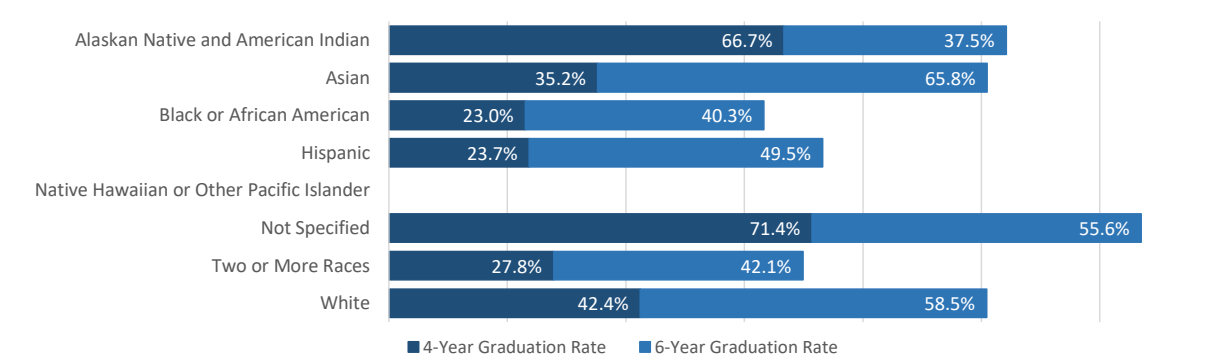

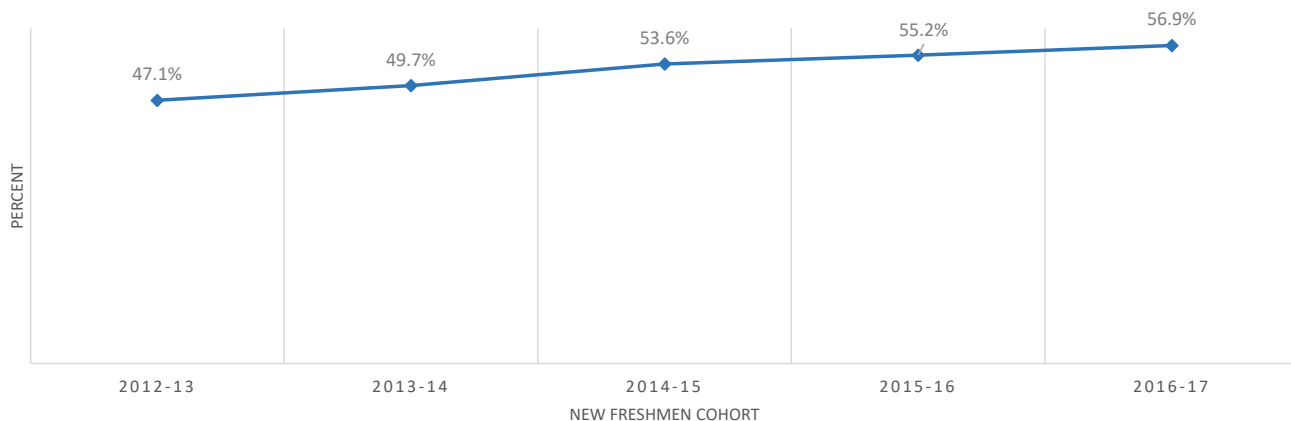
